Charles Jardine - awarded Honorary Membership in 2007

Charles Jardine is a well-known fly- fisherman, author and artist He has been a speaker at our winter meetings on several occasions. He is the National Director for the Countryside Alliance Foundation's 'Fishing for Schools' initiative.

He is also a England and Commonwealth fishing Gold Medallist.

In 2001 he kindly donated a framed print as a prize for the best coarse fish in the 25th birthday bash held by Invicta at Grafham and presented the prizes.

Peter Hartley – awarded Honorary Membership in 2009

Peter runs the highly successful 'School of Fishing' and was invited to join Invicta as an Honorary Member in 2009 in particular recognition of his support to local fly-fishing and his personal dedication to the sport.

He has always been involved with tuition for beginners. From season 2000 he has entered the England Eliminators 15 times, reached National or latterly Midland Finals 6 times and fished in the winning England team at Rutland in 2007. 1n 1989 he instigated and was the first secretary of the' Inter Club' competition which in 1991 became known as the AMFC. He remained as secretary until 2005, when he became a Vice President.
